



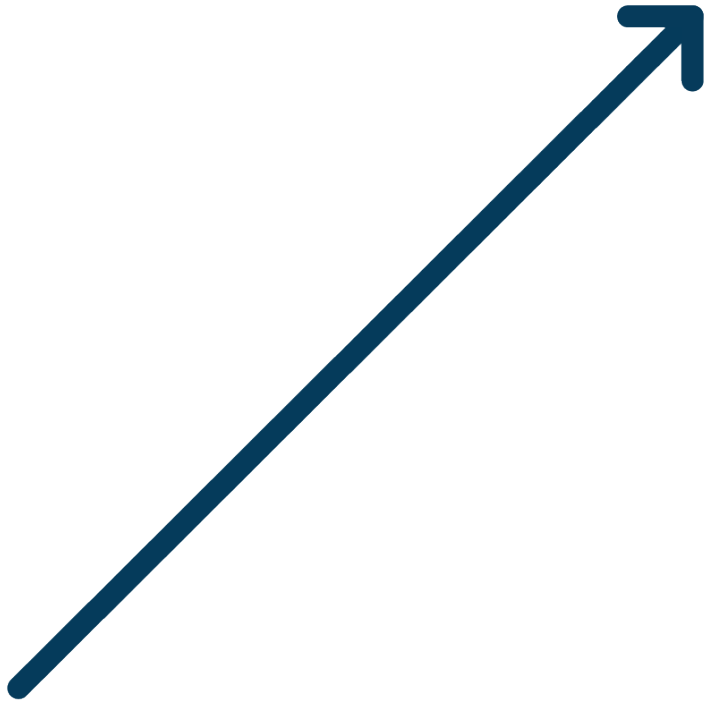

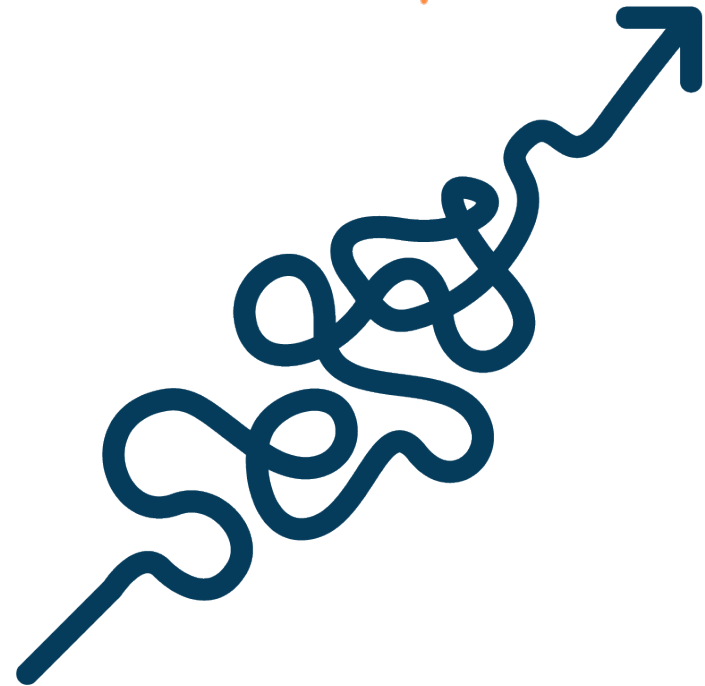

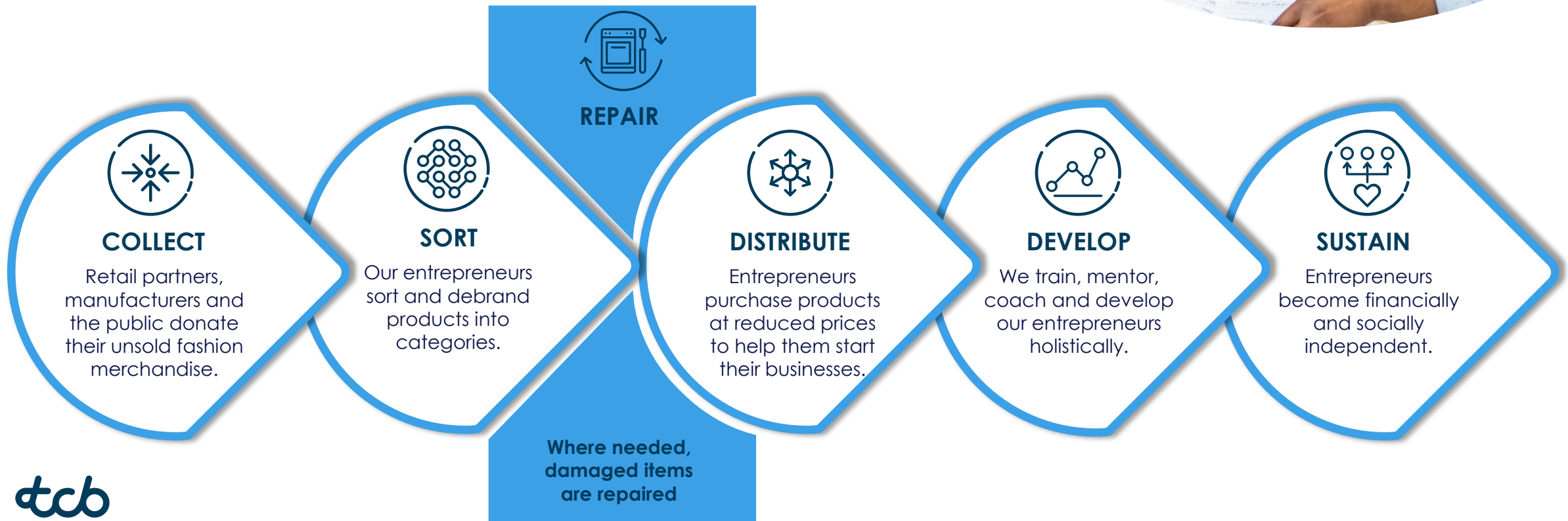


Equipping preschools to operate as sustainable businesses that deliver 5-star quality education in low-income communities at affordable rates.

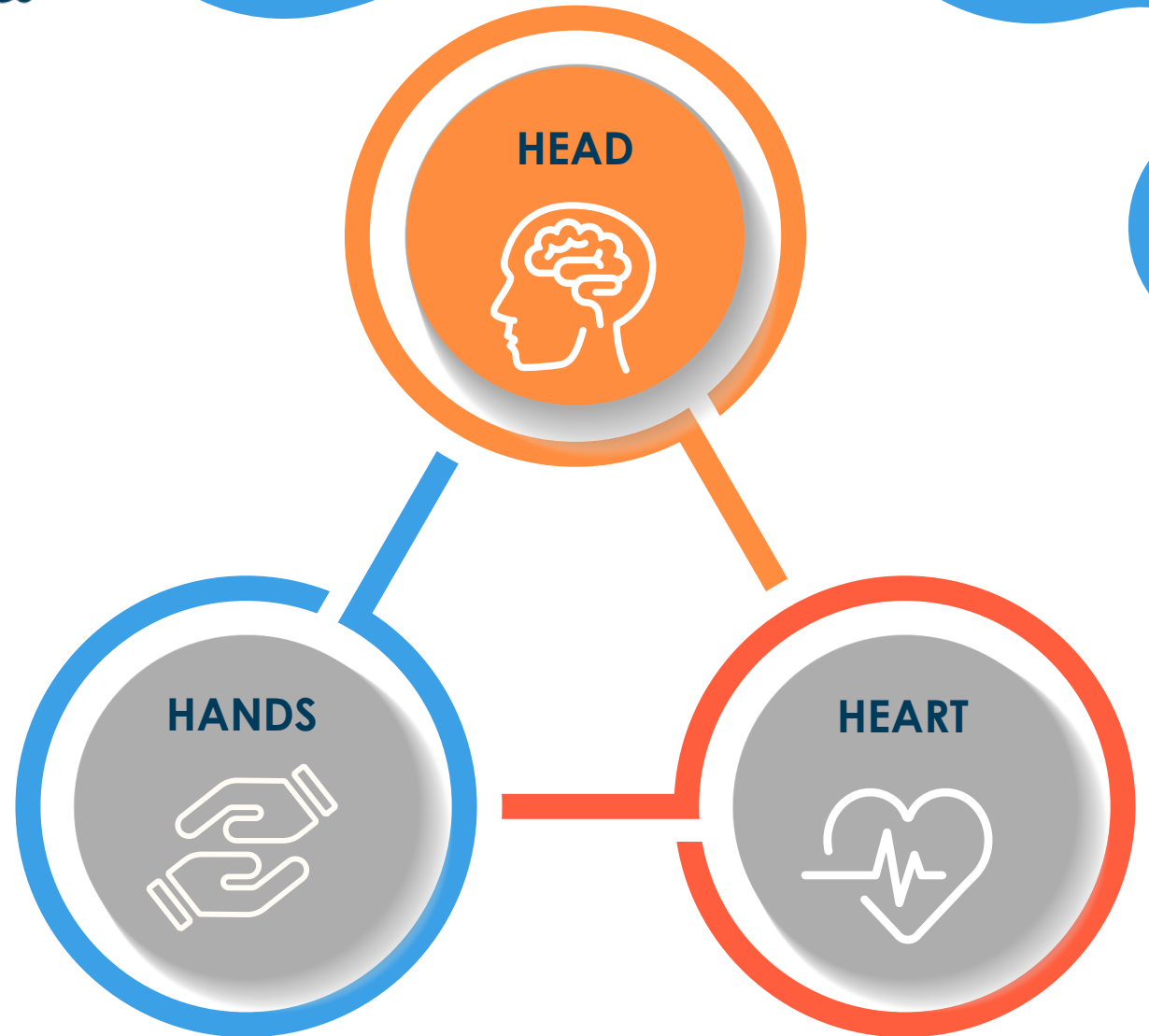
Previously known as The Clothing Bank.

Our Head, Hearts and Hands *model*

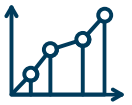

- Grade 10
- PDI (Previously Disadvantaged Individual)
- Able to commit full-time (no learnerships or part-time jobs)
- Reliable transport to our office
- Close enough to our office

- Eager to learn
- Community mindedness
- Previous experience in trading, running a business
- Open to change
- Has a support network
- Take responsibility for your life
